### *UHV Settlement Retrofit Supplement Instructions for Volkswagen Vehicles Equipped with a RNS 510 Radio and Navigation and Premium 8 Radios UHV = Bluetooth Module*

## Mobile phone pairing

### Pairing

- Make sure Bluetooth (BT) function on the mobile phone is on.
- Turn ignition on. This will make the UHV visible for 3 minutes. Car must be stationary.
- Initiate the search for Bluetooth devices from the mobile phone. A list of discovered devices should appear.
- Select VW Phone.
- If prompted for a pin, enter “0000” otherwise the phone will connect immediately.

Depending on the phone, a message may appear asking if you want to make “VW Phone” a trusted device or allow it to automatically reconnect. If desired, select yes to allow the automatic reconnect to occur.

When the ignition is switched on, the Bluetooth connection is automatically established.

Depending on the phone, a message may appear on the mobile device that requires authorization for the phonebook to be transferred to the vehicle, Press OK. If applicable, check the “Don’t show this message again” box.

### Multi-function Steering Wheel

- The volume buttons: work as normal – up/down phone volume control.
- Middle phone button: answer/hang-up calls/long press to redial last number called.

### Overhead Three-Button Module

- Mute button: mutes call.
- BT Button: makes UHV visible for 3 minutes.
- Push to Talk (PTT) Button: Activates UHV voice control. Say “Help” for a list of commands.
- Pressing the PTT button during a dialog will interrupt the voice control and allow the user to quickly say a command.
- Press the PTT button twice to exit voice control.

### Make a Call

Activate voice control with the PTT overhead button: Say “Call [John Smith]”, “Dial Number” or “Redial” to make calls.

### Reading of Phonebook

Activate voice control with the PTT overhead button: Say “Phone book” then “read all” – UHV will read the entire contact list alphabetically to user.

### ADP\*

Activate voice control with the PTT overhead button: Say “Music” to access the A2DP voice controls, then speak the following commands “Play”, “Stop”, “Pause”, “Previous Track” or “Next Track”.
